Large Family Discount- We understand the challenges of dishing out \$3-400 at once. If you have 3 children then the 3rd child can register for \$75 and if 4th child, they can register for \$50- This is calculated off the most expensive child's registration. Example, if you have 3 players @ \$100 & 1 player @ \$60 for Blastball your total registration would be \$50 + \$75 + \$100 + \$60, thus giving the discount to the more expensive registrations.

HELMET & FACE MASKS For Batters & Pitchers

Are now mandatory in the GBMSL for 2020 for all divisions up to & including Peewee (U14) You cannot go to bat without a face mask on your helmet, the league has no exceptions to this rule! We strongly recommend them for all levels of play. All pitchers must wear mask up to Peewee, no exceptions, this is Canada wide this year!

OUTSTANDING UNIFORMS

If you have a uniform outstanding, **you will not** be issued another one. You will be required to pay \$50 if a new one is required. You cannot play without a uniform.

We will not do refunds to players who register and then refuse to cover the outstanding uniform cost if required. Uniform pickup date will be announced on the website/facebook page

Divisions

Names from Tyke to Midget will likely be phased out and the standard U8,10,12,14,16 & 20 will be likely be implemented by the GBMSL over the next couple years.

Banquet

We cannot guarantee a position on any team, especially if the player registration is received after March 25th, 2020. If necessary, we will refund any registration amounts paid due to lack of players or if there is no division within GBMSL. Returning players from 2019 receive priority in making teams, in order of registration, with new players filling spots after that in order of their registration dates. Rule 5 & 11 below

Notes to Parents and acknowledgments:

Your signature at the bottom of this sheet confirms your acceptance of these notes as well as the waiver below.

1-It is the requirement of the Georgian Bay Minor Softball League (GBMSL) that a copy of a player's birth certificate be on file with us in the event that it is required to validate the age of a player.

2-Transportation to each game is the responsibility of the parent/player and "Not" the coach.

3-Each team is comprised of twelve/thirteen players. Every effort is made to place and play all registrants. This doesn't guarantee that we will be able to place everyone on a team.

4-All uniforms and equipment are the property of the Victoria Harbour Baseball Association and must be returned at the end of the season. If uniforms are not returned at season end there will be a \$50 charged to be assumed by the parent/guardian/player. This charge is to help cover the cost of the replacement. All outstanding amounts must be paid in full to register the following season. The complete uniform as handed out must be worn at all games. Sponsors help us to purchase uniforms and league rules require wearing them.

5-I realize that this is a team event and as such will do my utmost to see that my child attends their games and practices on time. I understand my child must attend as a minimum 66% of their games (regular season, tournament & playoffs). Failure to attend that # of games will disqualify them from awards and loss of their guaranteed spot within our program the following year. If that commitment does not exist, we ask that you do not register your child for this sport.

6-Coaches, assistant coaches, parent helpers and the executive are all volunteers, as such, we ask that they be given your respect and support in their endeavours.

7-I authorize Victoria Harbour Minor Ball to place information on their web page including photos, names and information relating to activities of their individual team's performances, awards, etc. No other personal information will be displayed

8-I understand my child will require a glove, a helmet with mask, pitching mask*, proper footwear and an athletic cup (especially if back catching). Cleats are expected at Squirt level and up. These items are required to play the game and if my child does not bring them to the game then I will not expect my child to play. *U14 and under*

9-The GBMSL has a code of conduct which my child and all adults are required to meet. This includes rules in regard to alcohol, cigarettes, bad language and negative cheering. I understand I could be asked to leave the park if I violate the code and that my child could eventually be removed from the team if a problem continued.

10- Minimum Ability Expectation- By the time a player reaches the Peewee division there is an expectation of a player being able to respond to a hit ball in a way that will help ensure their safety on the field. A Player who has no ability to catch a ball or even block a ball should not be playing at this level. This is a safety only concern as balls hit can be upwards of 74 km/hour (source-efastball.com) In situations where the teams are full (over 13 players) we reserve the right to do tryouts and make cuts based on ability

11- New players (those who didn't play last season in VHMB or those who lost their guarantee under rule 5) will be taken based on their order of registration and after all returning players have been given time to register. We will refund to any new players if a team is declared full at the time of our final registration.
